Mike Clark is the General Manager of Manufacturing at Toyota Motor Manufacturing Alabama. He is responsible for all production lines, including 4-cylinder, V6, and V8 engines.

The plant employs approximately 1,400 team members and is the only Toyota plant globally to produce 4-cylinder, V6 and V8 engines under one roof. Four expansions and a production volume of 700,000 engines annually makes Toyota Alabama one of the company's largest engine plants in the world.

Mike joined Toyota in 2002 as a quality engineer at the Georgetown, KY plant. In 2007 he was assigned to Toyota's global headquarters in Japan and later rotated to the Alabama plant as the Assistant Manager of Quality Engineering. He then worked his way up to General Manager of Manufacturing Support before being named General Manager of Manufacturing in 2018.

Before his career at Toyota, Mike held engineering positions with Shafer Valve Company, and Denso International America - a tier 1 supplier to Toyota.

Mike graduated from Ohio University with a BS in Electrical Engineering. He is active in the community and currently serves on the Board of Directors for Village of Promise.
